April Gardening Tips

- There is still time to plant trees and shrubs. Pruning evergreens can also be done during April.
- Plant annual seeds of Asters, Cosmos, Marigolds and Zinnias.
- Use a good rake to fluff up your lawn. It is probably matted down from the winter weather. It is also a good time thatch and overseed the lawn.
- Make sure that your lawn mower blade is sharp to prevent tearing of grass tips.
- As the days grow longer, houseplants should be rotated so that each side receives its share of light.
- Cut all of the dead canes from your raspberry plants. Uncover strawberries only when the danger of frost has passed.
- Root plants such as potatoes, radishes, parsnips and onions can be planted any time during April.
