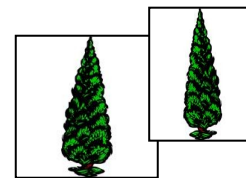

In The Woods

- Silt maintenance will be done Labor Day weekend on the upper pond.
- Grass carp fish (8) were added to the big pond by the clubhouse on August 12 with the approval of the DNR and Dept of the Interior. They are six months old and about 12 inches long. They love to eat vegetation. Hopefully they love the duckweed which has taken over the pond. They are expected to “work” for us for seven (7) years. Using regular bait should not be a problem. Note: They are incapable of reproducing so the pond will not become populated with hundreds of grass carp.
- The ponds are being sprayed bi-weekly for algae and primrose.
- Board members walk the sidewalks and grassy areas to stay abreast on problem areas. They have found piles of grass clippings and tree debris along these areas. These are contributing to the problems in our waterways. Please dispose of your debris in the proper manner to cut down on extra maintenance costs.
- Fountain in the upper pond has been turned off because of clogging due the silt and debris in the pond.
- The area around the playground was cut back to keep it open and clean for family use.
- Have any extra perennials? Plans are being made to beautify the area around the clubhouse.

August Gardening Tips

- ◆ Autumn is in the air!!! What a great summer this has been and hopefully it will be followed by a fabulous fall! What's next?
- ◆ Plant a fall crop of peas. The roots of peas "fix" nitrogen into the soil for next spring planting. Remember though. When planting peas for fall, plant them almost twice as deep as spring-planted peas. This will help keep the seeds cool and also from drying out before they germinate.
- ◆ Gather herbs and flowers for drying and preserving. The best time to gather herbs for drying is during the mid-morning hours, just after the dew has dried off the herbs, but before the sun causes them to wilt. Cut the herbs in clusters with the stems attached.
- ◆ Keep deadheading and harvesting your summer garden. In some of the cooler regions, it is still prime time for cukes, peppers, and tomatoes.
- ◆ Keep the moisture coming but not too much.
- ◆ But perhaps the most beneficial and foundational gardening tip for August is to sit back, iced tea in hand, and behold all that you have worked for. Watch the late season bees go about pollinating. Take in a nose full of the lavender sitting out to dry, oils gently dripping onto the porch. And bite into one of those rich, red, cherry tomatoes that seemed to have started so many months ago but fail to disappear.
