October Gardening Tips

Now is the time to finish your yard and garden clean-up and start your holiday decorating. Both tasks are more pleasant when the weather is a little warmer so try to complete them before the middle of the November.

- Keep mowing your lawn as long as the grass is growing.
- Drain your hoses and sprinklers and shut off hose faucets.
- Remove frozen plants from containers and hanging baskets and replace them with evergreen boughs, branches with colorful berries and interesting seed heads from perennials and ornamental grasses.
- Rake and compost large leaves.
- Change the oil, sharpen blades, clean air filters and replace spark plugs on all of your gas powered equipment. You will have a head start on many spring projects if all of your equipment is ready to go.
- Clean bird feeders, install squirrel guards and stock up on seed and suet. Birds add color and activity to your yard all winter and often stay in the spring to nest and raise their babies. If birds don't appear even though you provide a good selection of food it may be because your yard lacks shelter from cold winds and predators. Consider planting some pine, spruce or fir trees next spring.
