The Month of June

June is the sixth month of the year in the Gregorian calendar, with a length of 30 days.

The month is named after the Roman goddess Juno, wife of Jupiter and equivalent to the Greek goddess Hera.

June is the month with the longest daylight hours of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and the shortest daylight hours of the year in the Southern Hemisphere. The month of June—in the Northern Hemisphere—is in Spring until the 21st, when Summer begins.

The traditional June birthstone is the pearl. The June birth flower is the rose, or the honeysuckle, as roses and honeysuckles bloom throughout June. June is also sometimes called the "Rose month."

June is known for the large amount of marriages that occur over the course of the month. This large quantity of marriages can be attributed to the Goddess that June is named after, Juno or Hera. Juno is the protecting goddess of marriage and a married couple's household, so it is considered good luck to be married in this month."

MWP COMMON PROPERTY RULES 2014

- 1. No watercraft will be allowed on the canal or ponds between Glacier Drive and Yellowstone Parkway.*
- 2. No watercraft is to be left unattended on common grounds or waterways. Watercraft used on the large pond behind the clubhouse must be attended at all times or moved to private property before being left unattended.*
- 3. Nets and traps are not to be used to catch fish or wildlife on the common waterways. The removal from common property of any wildlife other than fish is not allowed.*
- 4. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the sidewalks, or on any other Greenbelt/common properties. (This does not refer to devices used by those with disabilities.)*
- 5. The use of paintball guns is not allowed on the common properties.*
- 6. Unauthorized use of the grounds and parking lots by and around the clubhouse and pool is not allowed after dark.*
- 7. No one is allowed to be swimming or wading for recreational purposes in any of the waterways.*

Continued violation of rules may result in loss of common property privileges.

National Night Out is designed to heighten crime and drug prevention awareness: generate support for and participation in local anticrime programs, such as Crimewatch groups; strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships and send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

Lifeguards Needed....Indy Parks announced an increase in the base pay of lifeguards from \$8 to \$10 per hour. If you, your children, friends or neighbors are interested in a fun, outdoor summer job, apply online at www.indy.gov/lifeguard/. NOTE: Indy Parks fully trains and certifies all lifeguards to meet national standards. To qualify, applicants must be at least 16 years old, a Marion County resident*, able to pass the swimming test consisting of; a 200 yard swim using front crawl or breast stroke; one minute tread with hands out of the water; and successful retrieval of a 10-pound diving brick from 12 feet of water.

English Learner Classes — St. Mark Catholic School will host 12 sessions of English Learner Classes this summer beginning Monday, June 9th and Wednesday, June 11th.
