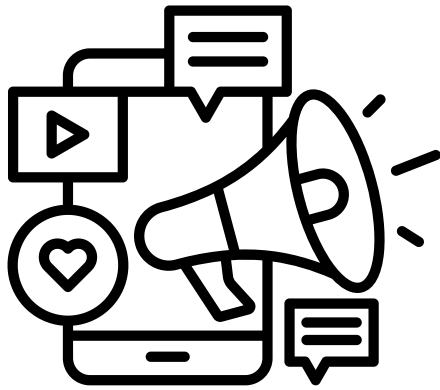

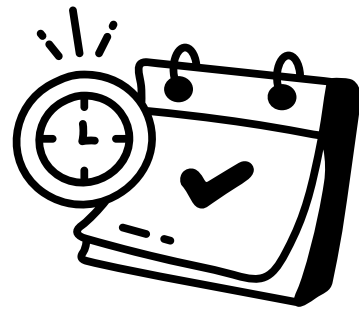

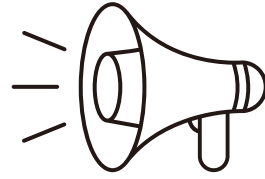

Overgrown Grass

The HOA is not responsible for enforcing lawn maintenance between neighbors. However, if a yard's grass exceeds 12 inches, you may file a complaint with the city. Please note, the city's charge for mowing is approximately \$340 per cut—so staying on top of it is in everyone's best interest! The HOA's primary responsibilities include maintaining common areas such as the pool, clubhouse, waterways, and sidewalks. That's what your dues are for! If you have concerns about a neighboring property, we encourage you to start with a friendly conversation—there may be a genuine reason. You can also submit a formal concern to the city here:

Backside Sidewalk Maintenance

If your property backs up to a neighborhood sidewalk, please remember to mow up to the path and trim back any overhanging branches. It keeps our walking paths safe and welcoming for everyone!

Delinquent Dues

Homeowner accounts that remain unpaid for an extended period will be subject to a lien on the property, in accordance with the HOA's governing documents and Indiana law. In some cases, and only as permitted by law, additional legal action may be taken to recover the balance.

Our dues are very fair and help fund essential maintenance, pool operations, and neighborhood events that benefit the entire community.

Timely payment ensures Meridian Woods Park remains a safe, welcoming, and enjoyable place to live.
